U.S.-Flag Cargo Movement on Lakes Up 13.4 Percent in September

CLEVELAND — U.S.-flag Great Lakes freighters (lakers) moved 10.5 million tons of cargo in September, an increase of 13.4 percent compared to a year ago. The September float was also 7.4 percent above the month's 5-year average.

Iron ore cargos for steel production totaled 5.3 million tons, an increase of 14 percent compared to a year ago.

Coal loads totaled 1.4 million tons, an increase of 9 percent compared to a year ago. Shipments of limestone totaled 3.2 million tons, an increase of 13.3 percent compared to a year ago.

Year-to-date U.S.-flag cargo movement stands at 65.1 million tons, an increase of 12.9 percent compared to the same point in 2018. Iron ore cargos total 35.2 million tons, an increase of 12.8 percent. Coal loadings total 8.3 million tons, an increase of 6.9 percent. Limestone totals 17.9 million tons, an increase of 14.1 percent.
