## **Great Lakes Iron Ore Trade Down in July**

CLEVELAND – Shipments of iron ore on the Great Lakes totaled 5.3 million tons in July, a decrease of 6.8 percent compared to a year ago. Shipments were also 6.3 percent below the month's 5-year average.

Year-to-date the iron ore trade stands at 19.1 million tons, a decrease of 27.8 percent compared to the same point in 2021. Iron ore shipments are 25.5 percent below their 5-year average for the first seven months of the year.

Since 1880, Lake Carriers' has represented the U.S.-flag Great Lakes fleet, which today can move more than 90 million tons of cargos annually that are the foundation of American industry, infrastructure, and power: iron ore, stone, coal, cement, and other dry bulk materials such as grain, salt, and sand.
